The organization aims to not only highlight these incredible structures to make the public more aware of them, but also prevent their demolition through conservation and fundraising efforts.

From Mies van der Rohe's controversial Farnsworth House to Le Corbusier's classic Villa Savoye and everything in between, IconicHouses.org provides information and images of these now house museums to the viewers, as well as links to their websites for easy access. The site also features an interactive map documenting the distribution of these buildings worldwide.
